# New boutique for clients to 'shop' in

One of our community ministry partners, Next Step Crisis Pregnancy Center, is delighted to be in a new facility. Located on the northwest corner of 196<sup>th</sup> St. SW and 64<sup>th</sup> Ave. W, their new facility nearly doubles their old space. They now have room for more privacy for interviews and pregnancy tests. They have a conference room for staff and board meetings. They have a boutique room where clients can come and pick up free maternity clothes and clothes for children: infant through 2 year old (some larger sizes are available for older siblings).

These facilities are made possible by a generous supporter who provided the funds for the building and its complete renovation. Next Step provides free pregnancy tests and ultra sounds for women and couples. Their goal is to provide a safe place for women to make a pregnancy decision.

The greatest need they have for their clients is disposable diapers. Any brand, new born through size 6 are needed. Kirkland brand works very well because Costco will allow them to trade sizes, if needed. If you would like to bless Next Step with diapers, pick up a box on your next shopping trip and drop them off.
