Message from the pastor

Lean In & Reach Out

Dear Faith Family,

This Sunday my sermon will be about looking back on 2020 and looking ahead at 2021. While it's no surprise that 2020 was totally different than expected, and most likely 2021 will have more of the same (at least for a while), our church mission is still, "to be/make genuine disciples of Jesus, transforming our community/world with His love."

For this reason, this new year, I am asking our church family to make a concerted effort to **Lean In & Reach Out.** Lean in is about doing the things we can to grow closer to Jesus. Reach out has to do with reaching out to our friends, neighbors, and community in intentional efforts to draw them closer to Jesus.
